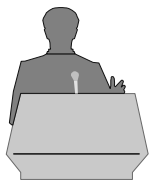


## Prayer Requests:

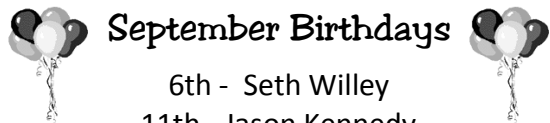

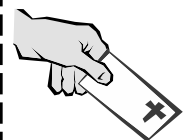
