

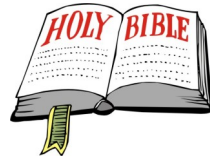


Prayer Requests:

- Please pray for those not with us today



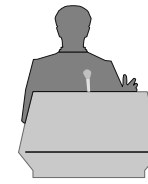
Welcome to Our Gospel Meeting!

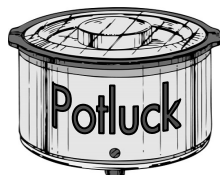

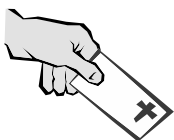

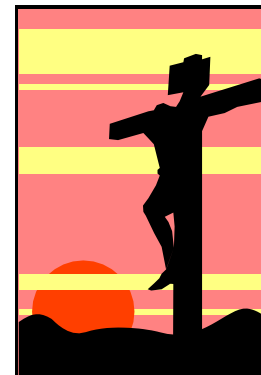
