Inner Peace

(Is It Well With Your Soul?)

*When peace like a river, attendeth my way,
When sorrows, like sea billows roll;
Whatever my lot, Thou hast taught me to say,
"It is well, It is well, with my soul."*

Many are unaware that the encouraging, faith-filled words of this familiar hymn were written soon after Horatio G. Spafford had lost all four of his daughters in a shipwreck on November 22, 1873. Even in the midst of tremendous loss and consuming grief, he experienced an inward peace and comfort only God can give.

The Lord Jesus Christ promised His beloved peace. "Peace I leave with you, My peace I give to you; not as the world gives do I give to you. Let not your heart be troubled, neither let it be afraid" (John 14:27).

Too often, however, our hearts *are* troubled and afraid. We, like Martha of old, become distracted [drawn away; over-occupied—*Vines*] and "worried and troubled about many things" (Luke 10:38-42). But one thing is needful. We must strive to maintain our spiritual bearing, keeping our focus on Christ who is our life! (Col 3:1-4).

As always, the inspired word of God offers some real help here. "Be anxious for nothing (don't worry about anything), but in everything, by prayer and supplication, with thanksgiving, let your requests be made known to God; and the **peace of God**, which surpasses all understanding, will guard your hearts and minds through Christ Jesus" (Phil 4:6-7). What a promise!

When we faithfully cast our burdens upon the Lord, He will sustain us (Psalm 55:22) and grant us a peace that only He can give. "Thou wilt keep him in perfect peace, whose mind is stayed on Thee: because he trusteth in Thee (Isaiah 26:3). Is it well with your soul? — **Terry Schmidt** ✍

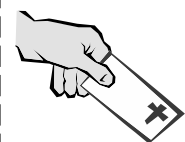
