## Happy Mother's Day!



Our beloved country has a proud history of honoring our mothers. The effort to show public appreciation for mothers began in 1872 when Julia Ward Howe organized a special day for mothers to be remembered and honored. In 1907, Anna M. Jarvis began a movement to set up a national Mother's Day.

Through this effort, hundreds of legislators and prominent businessmen were asked to help create a special day to honor our nation's mothers. All this hard work finally paid off in the year 1914, when President Woodrow Wilson proclaimed the second Sunday in May as a national holiday in honor of mothers.

Our loving Father created motherhood and His word holds mothers in a place of high regard, encouraging followers of Christ to do the same. Children are exhorted to "Honor your father and mother..." (Ephesians 6:2). The apostle Paul commends young Timothy's sincere faith "which first lived in your grandmother Lois and in your mother Eunice, and I am persuaded, now lives in you also" (2 Timothy 1:5). The loving, patient teaching of these godly women resulted in this young evangelist's commitment to Christ and lifelong service to His church.

Paul exalts motherhood when he tells the church in Thessalonica, "we were gentle among you, like a mother caring for her little children" (2 Thessalonians 2:7). Of such nurturing mothers the book of Proverbs says, "Her children arise and call her blessed; her husband also, and he praises her" (Proverbs 31:28). May we find similar ways to show our appreciation for the mothers in our lives, not only on this special day, but every day of the year.
