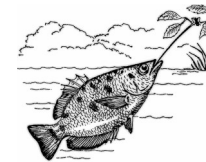

God's Creative Genius

The Archer fish overcomes a problem in sea to air ballistics by squirting water at his prey, which are bugs and flies. His mouth has a built in groove that channels the water like a squirt gun. But, as impressive as this is, the biggest problem is his aim. He has to overcome the refractive difference from water to air in order to accurately hit his prey. If you ever looked at a spoon in a glass of water, you would understand the problem. The refractive quality of water distorts the image of the spoon and makes it appear to be broken in half. But, the Archer fish performs this amazing task with great efficiency and accuracy. Again we must marvel at God's design!
