

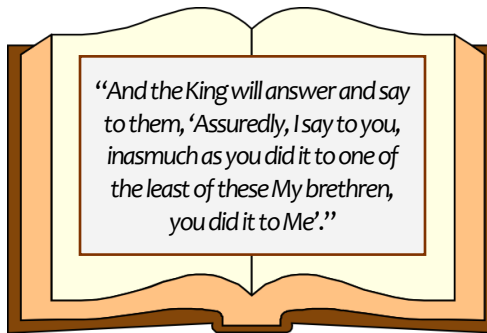


Prayer Requests:
