Heart Disease



The cities of Sodom and Gomorrah were doomed to destruction because of the vile & sinful life-style of its depraved inhabitants. Lot and his wife were warned by angels of God with these urgent words: "Escape for your life! Do not look behind you nor stay anywhere in the plain. Escape to the mountains, lest you be destroyed." (Gen 19:17). As Lot and his family fled to the city of Zoar and the Lord's judgement fell upon Sodom and Gomorrah, Lot's wife, who had been warned, "Do not look behind you," looked back and became a pillar of salt (Gen 19:26).

She was *motivated* to depart Sodom because of the urgency of the angel's warning to leave, but she was not *convinced* nor *converted*. She was seeking safety, but had divided interests and, perhaps, hidden desires. Her doom is rendered all the more regrettable when we consider the fact that she had nearly escaped! Ultimately, she was lost because her heart was still in Sodom. She left the city—*physically*, perhaps reluctantly, with her husband and family. But *spiritually*, in her heart, she still longed for Sodom.

Heart disease is both dangerous and deadly. As the number one cause of death in this country, it claims about 700,000 lives annually. Symptoms often go unnoticed until it is too late. Each year more than 1 million Americans experience a heart attack with nearly half of them having no prior warning signs. And an estimated 30 million Americans have one or more types of heart disease. But most are unaware of this and think they are fine!

As the example of Lot's wife teaches us, *spiritual* heart disease is just as insidious and just as deadly. Moreover, this sin-based disease carries with it eternal consequences. And the sobering truth is, it can affect believers as easily as unbelievers! As the inspired writer of the Letter to the Hebrews warns, "Take heed, brethren, lest there be in any of <u>you</u> an evil heart of unbelief, in departing from the living God. But exhort one another daily, while it is called Today; lest any of <u>you</u> be hardened through the deceitfulness of sin" (Heb 3:12-13). As we can

see, this condition is very serious and merits deliberate attention and constant vigilance.

When spiritual heart disease progresses to the point of one being "hardened through the deceit-fulness of sin," the only cure is the living and powerful word of God. The Great Physician skill-fully applies the truth of His word which is "sharper than any two-edged sword, piercing [penetrating; convicting] even to the division of soul and spirit ... and is a discerner of the thoughts and intents of the heart" (Hebrews 4:12). Only the living and powerful [active & efficacious] word of God, with the precision of a surgeon's scalpel, can peel the callous off a hardened heart and restore it to health and wholeness.

Since all have sinned and fall short of the glory of God (Romans 3:23), all of us are candidates for spiritual heart surgery. And sometimes, those who need it the most are completely unaware that they do! So, schedule an immediate appointment with the Great Physician and have a thorough spiritual examination (Ps 139:23; Jer 17:10). Perhaps some of us like the Psalmist need to say, "LORD, be merciful to me; heal my soul (heart), for I have sinned against You" (Psalm 41:4).
