## Prudence



When Jesus sent out the Twelve on their limited commission, He cautioned: "Behold, I send you out as sheep in the midst of wolves. Therefore, be wise as serpents and harmless as doves" (Matthew 10:16). All New Testament Christians are also cautioned: "See then that you walk circumspectly [carefully; cautiously], not as fools, but as wise, redeeming the time, because the days are evil" (Ephesians 5:15-16). Both these verses highlight the need for us to maintain our spiritual vigilance and can be summed up in one word: prudence.

This word is derived from the Latin prudens meaning "far-sighted" or "acting with foresight." In the Hebrew, it is synonymous with discernment, meaning the ability to judge well and make sound decisions. "I, wisdom, dwell with prudence, and find out knowledge and discretion" (Proverbs 8:12). Simply and generally defined, prudence is practical wisdom promoting, through the ability of reason and thoughtful consideration, a healthy sense of caution and restraint in the management life's affairs. The word is also synonymous with common sense and is associated with exercising good, sound judgment.

This is why the wise man Solomon asserts, "Every prudent man acts with knowledge (Proverbs 13:16); "considers well his steps (14:15); "receives reproof [correction] (15:5); "acquires knowledge" (18:15); is "crowned with knowledge" (14:18) and is "wise in heart" (16:21). Of course, the knowledge and wisdom spoken of here refers to the will and the ways of God. This enables the prudent to foresee evil [danger] and hide himself [prepare and take adequate precautions], while the simple [foolish, unthinking persons] pass

on and are punished, suffering the consequences of their foolish actions (22:3; 27:12).

So, how do we obtain this most excellent quality? Prudence is equally promised to the simple and inexperienced, as well as to the wise and learned. It comes through the knowledge and wisdom found in God's word, which freely imparts the gift of prudence to those who will faithfully study its pages (Proverbs 1:1-7; 8:12-21), and diligently apply its truth to their lives (Proverbs 4:20-27; James 1:22-25). — Terry Schmidt &
